Installation of Solar Power Generating System

A second unit of 5 KW solar power generating system has been installed at a cost of Rs. 4,42,750 by utilizing CIICP funds at our polytechnic college. Both units give an average power output of 60 units per day.

Centre for High Skill Training and Research

Centre for High Skill Training and Research has been established in our Polytechnic in collaboration with Bosch Rexroth, Germany as per the Tamilnadu Government G.O No.167 dated 21.07.2011 to conduct course on Industrial Automation. A total grant of Rs. 3.00 crores for the purchase of Equipment and Rs. 40.00 lakhs as recurring grant for a period of two years has been sanctioned by State Project Coordination Unit(SPCU)DOTE, Chennai.

The centre will be established in two years period of time with the state of art facilities to conduct the following courses for students and faculty of other Polytechnic and Engineering colleges and industry participants

1. Pneumatics. 2. Hydraulics. 3. Sensors and its applications 4. PLC and SCADA Systems 5. Bus Technology 6. Mechatronics 7. Simulation modules.

Two staff members of EEE department, Dr. V.R. Velmurugan and Mr. G. Rajagopal were deputed to undergo training programme on Lab view Core 1 and Core 2 at National Instruments, Bangalore from 12th to 16th June 2017 and they were also deputed to SIEMENS, Singapore to undergo specialized training programme on PLC and IoT from 3rd to 12th July 2017 by utilizing HSTC training funds.
